PHOTOSENSITIZING FOODS AND MEDICATIONS

Certain drugs and food groups do not mix well with ultraviolet light either in its natural or artificial source. Researchers including Dr. Richard Childers, a dermatologist at the University of Florida, and Dr. Edward Emmett of John Hopkins University, compiles a list of drugs, foods, and other substances which could make your skin super-sensitive to ultraviolet light. Should you be taking any of the following, a doctor's release is necessary before you begin tanning with an indoor system. After the doctor's release is complete and you have begun tanning process, should there be any negative reactions experienced, **PLEASE** notify the receptionist immediately.
